The Sheep Centre is an interpretation and experiential attraction. Visitors can immerse themselves in a working farm, enjoy quality meals and learn about best practice landcare and farming techniques.

Landpack

1 hour, landcare tour, mini bushwalk, tree planting. Possum and insect discovery.

Take a guided tour through a 5 hectare conservation block that has been fenced off from sheep for 15 years. 63 species of native plants live in this block.

Collect some native tree seed or plant some trees to leave your own mark of environmental repair whilst assisting Tim and Jane with their vision.

Morning tea included. \$33.00 per person.

Woolpack

1 hour, tour with dogs to see sheep and crops. Explore the woolshed pipeline.

Take the dogs on a farm tour, walk through the cabbage patch and round up some sheep. Your guide will explain our production systems and International destinations of our produce such as; Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Germany and Canada. Take a tour of the woolshed to see where the sheep are shorn and how the fleece is prepared for market.

Morning tea included \$33.00 per person.
